On a Communication from the  
 Commissioners of Public Works dated  
 21<sup>st</sup> August 1854, submitting a  
 Schedule and Description (annexed)  
 of certain Islands situated in the  
 River Ottawa, also of that part of Grey  
 Reserve Lot No. 39 Range Letter A  
 fronting on the River Ottawa in the  
 Township of Nepean, reserved for Public  
 Purposes and requesting that Authority  
 may be issued for placing the same  
 under the control of the Department  
 of Public Works, to be applied to the  
 purposes of Provincial Works when  
 required for such; and, when not so  
 required, to be disposed of by Lease,  
 or otherwise, as the Department may  
 deem proper.

The Committee recommend  
 that the Islands and Lot in question  
 be placed under the control of the  
 Department of Public Works for the  
 purposes mentioned.

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Schedule and Description of Certain Islands  
Situated on the River Ottawa also of that  
part of Clergy Reserve Lot No 39 Range Letter A  
fronting on the River Ottawa in the Township of Nepean  
reserved for Public Purposes

1. Stoney Island otherwise known as Pine Tree Island,  
situated in Dred Channel of the River Ottawa below  
the Chaudiere Falls opposite that part of Upper Bytown  
situated on part of Reserve B in the Township of Nepean
2. Chaudiere Island, South of the Chaudiere Falls, in the vicinity  
of Bytown
3. Albert Island, - South of Chaudiere Island, and also  
South of the former Buchanan's Slides Channel of the River  
Ottawa
4. Coffin Island, South of Albert Island, and also North  
of the Government Slides Channel
5. Victoria Island - South East of Chaudiere Island  
and North of the Government Slides Channel
6. The Several large and small Islands and Shoals  
in the Ottawa River, between the little Chaudiere and  
the Great Chaudiere Falls, North of the township of Nepean.  
The several small Islands and Shoals at and in the  
vicinity of the Remicks' Rapid in the Ottawa River,  
North of the Township of Nepean
7. The Small Islands and Shoals at the Duchene rapids  
in the Ottawa River, at the foot of the Chaudiere Lake.
8. The portion of the Clergy Reserve Lot No 39, reserved  
for Public Purposes, in Range Letter A, fronting on the  
River Ottawa, Township of Nepean
9. McDonnell's Island, and the small Islands back  
thereof, situated at the head of the Chaudiere Lake in  
front of the Village of Litton in the Township of Litton
10. Victoria Island, situated at the falls of the Chaudiere

- at the foot of the Chats' Lake, and also North of Lots Nos. 23  
 & 24 in the ninth Concession of the Township of Litzel.
12. Crane Island, situated at the Falls of the Chats, at the foot of the Chats' Lake and immediately South of Victoria Island.
  13. Killaly's Island, situated at the Falls of the Chats' at the foot of the Chats' Lake, and immediately South of Victoria Island.
  14. A Small Island situated between Crane and Killaly Islands and South of the same -
  15. Mill Island, situated North of Victoria Island -
  16. The Small Islands in the vicinity of Mill Island and Almond Island, as represented on the Plan of Survey of J. J. Roney, P. L. S. in the Office of Public Works -
  17. Almond Island, situated at the Falls of the Chats' at the foot of the Chats' Lake, between Victoria and Great Chats' Islands.
  18. Chabot Island - situated at the Falls of the Chats' between Almond Island and Great Chats' Island -
  19. All the Small Islands situated between the aforesaid Chabot and Great Chats' Islands -
  20. Great Chats' Island, heretofore known as Morris' Island - situated at the Falls of the Chats', at the foot of Chats' Lake -
  21. Courrois' Island, situated at the Falls of the Chats' at the foot of the Chats' Lake, West of Great Chats' Island -
  22. The Small Islands between Great Chats' Island and Courrois' Island, and in front of the last named Island -
  23. Egan's Island, situated at the Falls of the Chats', West of Courrois' and Great Chats' Islands -
  24. The Small Islands at the Falls of the Chats', situated South and West of Egan's Island -

Note -

All the last mentioned Islands at the Falls of the Chats are described, as laid down on the Plan of Survey, deposited by J. J. Roney, P. L. S. in the Office of Public Works -

25. All the Islands, not included in the foregoing Enumeration, large or small, situated between the Falls of the Chats' and the Rapids above the same, at the foot of the Chats' Lake -
